

FIRST AID AND EMERGENCY CARE

Schools are responsible for giving first aid or emergency treatment in case of sudden illness or injury to students or members of the staff. Further medical attention to students is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s), or of someone the parent(s) or guardian(s) designates in case of emergency.

Building principals are charged with providing for the immediate care of ill or injured persons within their areas of control. A school nurse or other qualified staff member will administer emergency aid.

In each school, procedures for the handling of such emergencies will be established and made known to the staff. Each school and school vehicle will be equipped with appropriate first aid equipment.

All employees are expected to be knowledgeable about first aid and to know where first aid supplies are kept in their work areas.
