OFFER VS. SERVE (FOOD SERVICES)

The “Offer vs. Serve Option” is designed to be more economical for MSAD #56 and result in less waste. All lunches must contain five food items, but students have the freedom of choice in selecting the three, four or five items they intend to consume. They may refuse up to two items. All breakfasts must contain four food items, but students have the freedom to refuse one food item.

The Offer vs. Serve concept shall be implemented in MSAD #56 schools. The Food Service Director shall be responsible for implementing appropriate administrative procedures and communications to carry out this policy in conformance with state and federal regulations and applicable Board policies.
