

## **CRISIS RESPONSE PLAN**

It is the policy of MSAD #56 that each individual school shall prepare and have in place a Crisis Response Plan. The Superintendent and building administrators shall be responsible for ensuring that the plan is implemented in each school and evaluated on an annual basis, and after each incident when the plan is used. It is understood that specific procedures may vary from school to school due to differences in school facilities and the ages of students.

As required by law, the Board of Directors will approve the plan annually. Any substantive changes in the plan shall be subject to the approval of the Board.

It is understood that in case of a local emergency/disaster that the school facilities may be available for use as a disaster center.
