

USE OF DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION BY NON-PROFIT GROUPS

The Superintendent of Schools and/or the Director of Transportation and Maintenance may authorize the use of district transportation equipment and/or personnel for the use of non-profit groups who are residents of the district. The using group will be held responsible for the costs of operation such as fuel, oil, vandalism, accidental damage and the operator's fee unless specified otherwise by the Board of Directors.

Trips requested by non-profit groups are limited to an area within an eighty mile radius of Searsport. Such requested trips are subject to the availability of the transportation equipment and employees when not being used for school purposes.

The use of transportation equipment and personnel will be approved only when the group requesting such use submits a written request at least fourteen (14) days prior to the use, designating the number of riders, the dates and hours of use, the pickup and delivery places and such other information as deemed appropriate.
