

COMMUNITY USE OF ATM EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES

ATM facilities owned by MSAD #56 are primarily for district educational purposes. When not in use by district personnel for educational purposes, the ATM equipment and facilities may be available for use by community groups and organizations such as the University of Maine, Husson College, etc. to provide courses and other professional development activities.

The use of the ATM equipment and facilities must be scheduled with the high school principal at least two weeks in advance. An appropriate fee, as determined by the Superintendent of Schools, will be charged for each session to help defray equipment replacement and upkeep. A representative from the district will be responsible for unlocking and locking the ATM Center and the building. The organization using the facilities is also responsible for the special regulations noted in policy KF-R, Community Use of School Facilities.
